CHAPTER 1

INTOXICATING LIQUORS

SECTION

8-101. Prohibited generally.

8-101. Prohibited generally. Except as authorized by applicable laws² and/or ordinances, it shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, receive, possess, store, transport, sell, furnish, or solicit orders for, any intoxicating liquor or alcoholic beverage within the Town of Graysville. "Intoxicating liquor" shall be defined to include whiskey, wine, "home brew," "moonshine," and all other intoxicating, spirituous, vinous, or malt liquors and beers which contain more than five percent (5%) of alcohol by weight. "Alcoholic beverage" shall be defined to include any alcoholic beverage, including "beer" and "ale" which contains five percent (5%) or less of alcohol by weight. (Ord. # 1985-2, modified)
