I'm mid ways thru typing it and soon as I get it typed I will give you all a copy of it. It's just how the money is taking in, who's handling the money and how it's processed just to show a segregation of duties, so that the same person who is taking in the money aint the one who's taking it to the bank, who's reconciling the bank statements just different things like that. It's just internal controls to show that there is a segregation of duties as much as possible for each municipality."

Commissioner May "Are you the one doing that or is Amanda the one doing that?"

City Recorder Pankey "Amanda takes in the money, her and Michelle work together to close out her drawer during the day, Amanda or I will take the bank bag and then I reconcile the bank statements every month."

Mayor Doss "And library does the same thing?"

City Recorder Pankey "Uh ha."

Mayor Doss "In my wife's office every employee whose duties is to handle money has their own box of money and each day they have to do this, they been doing it for years. I don't know if that's what this is?"

City Recorder Tracey Pankey "Yes and Amanda takes in all the money that comes thru and the only time any other cashier, myself and Michelle is considered cashiers for the city but the only time her and I ever have to handle any money is if Amanda is unavailable. But the internal control is to just show the segregation of duties."
