# Policy on Take Home Vehicles Update

Vice Mayor Reel "I'm okay with just the heads taking them home."

Mayor Doss "That will park two, Bobby and Potter would have to park theirs. Anyone want to put that in form of a motion?"

A motion that only the department heads have take home vehicles was made by Vice Mayor Reel...

Mayor Doss "And one of the other things discussed was if they are on vacation it would be passed down to the next person inline."

Vice Mayor Reel "Yes I'm fine with that."

Commissioner Beene "When will we implement this and will we draw it up as a policy?"

## **Employee Wages & Salaries**

Mayor Doss "In the workshop we talked about employee wages and salaries; one of the things was the chief of police and the advice we had was to put the chief on hourly based on forty hours there's no overtime in police department until they reach eighty six hours in a pay period?"

City Recorder Pankey "Yes sir."

Mayor Doss "So anything over eighty hours would still be straight time until eighty six hours and it's based on \$15.90 an hour. From what I understand by law thru our attorney that's the best route to take. Is that your advice?"

City Attorney Ed Boring "Yes."

A motion to pay her by the hour at \$15.90 was made by Vice Mayor Reel; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mayor Doss.

Mayor Doss "Now under discussion this is what the police chief was making prior Julies hiring."

Motion carried 2-1. Commissioner Beene voting No.

Mayor Doss "So in reality it doesn't change her pay unless she works beyond her eighty six hours."

#### Hannah Solar Update

City Recorder Pankey "We missed the deadline this year the deadline was November 18, 2015 but it was actually on a first come first serve basis. They will start taking applications again in January and III fill out application." Commissioner Beene "And we want to be the first one to apply to."

Mayor Doss "To move to new business, I don't think we have to vote on this but I want to bring it to the board and I'll ask Bobby McMillon to address us with some things since he has got a different vehicle. It is under the amount that is required to have a vote but he just wants to let us know about things here."

Animal Control/Code Enforcement Bobby McMillon "Lettering on the vehicle, having code enforcement/animal control put on the vehicle, dog box for transportation of animals. This vehicle has a third seat which will have to be taken out and box put in to transport animals. Price on the lettering is not installed is \$200.00 and installed is \$300.00, on the dog box it is \$369.99 from Co Op.

Police Chief Julie Tanksly "Yes sir."

Mayor Doss "One day in the back I caught you putting lettering on you vehicles, could you help Bobby put lettering on his vehicle?"

Police Chief Tanksly "Yes sir."

Mayor Doss "That would save us one hundred dollars."

Animal Control/Code Enforcement McMillon "We need more safety lighting because what it has is hard to see when they are on. I have one other question the deal with driving my vehicle home I don't get to do that no more?"

City Recorder Pankey & Mayor Doss (together/same time) "We tabled that."

Mayor Doss "It's up for farther workshop."

Animal Control/Code Enforcement McMillon "Can I make a comment on that?"

Mayor Doss "Sure."

Animal Control/Code Enforcement McMillon "I believe I am about the only idiot that's been truly doing what he is supposed to do with the vehicle. I don't know what the deal is coming about me not driving my vehicle home, I

come in on all kinds of calls in the time I been here I have come in on two dog bite on kids calls. The time I have to take to swap cars it's a waste of time."

Mayor Doss "I don't think the board pin pointing anybody."

Animal Control/Code Enforcement McMillon "I believe it is that's my thoughts but I'll leave it up to the board."

Mayor Doss "In the workshop nobody's name was thrashed."

Animal Control/Code Enforcement McMillon "I don't believe what other people's done by misuse and all I don't believe that's right taking it out on peoples that's right. I'm trying to do the best for the City of Graysville and my job and I do my job well."

Mayor Doss "Thank you sir."

Commissioner Beene "Thank you Bobby."
